Lessons are offered for first time twirlers, non-competitive skills classes for children through adults, community performers, competitive twirlers for novice through elite, and those wishing to be a part of a competitive team. CLASS ATTIRE:

Ambition t-shirt or tank top, black stretch shorts or leggings, tennis shoes and jazz shoes.
Hair secured away from face and neck. Bun preferred.
Students are asked to wear tennis shoes (rather than sandals or crocs, etc.)

TYPES OF CLASSES OFFERED:

ACADEMY- This class includes instruction in basic baton, dance, and acro skills, and is designed to introduce students to the artistic sport of baton twirling without any pressures of performance or testing. Students are invited to participate in parades and community performances if interested but are not required

ENSEMBLE - This class includes instruction in basic baton, dance, and acro skills, and is designed to introduce students to the artistic sport of baton twirling while offering opportunities to participate in parades, community performances, and an end of the year recital.

Adult Fun Class - This class is designed for former twirlers or any adult that would like to stay active and try learning new skills.

***Auditions are offered in August each year for our competition teams for anyone with at least one year of twirling experience..** If selected to participate, a team invitation will follow with all information needed for the year. Competition teams meet 1 weekend per month in Needville, Texas.

EXPENSES:

TUITION PER SESSION:

Session I - September through December (Ten 45 minute classes)

Session II - January through April (Ten 45 minute classes)

\$250 total or pay in monthly installments (\$10 registration fee and \$60 for 4 months)

Tuition due at the first class of the session, or the first class each month

Tuition is not prorated for missed classes. Any cancellation by the teacher will be made up at the end of the session.

- * Optional Private lessons - \$35 per ½ hour
- *Facility rental if needed is not included in private lesson fee, Most lessons occur at my home.
- *USTA Membership \$10— includes insurance, ability to evaluate, educational materials, etc.
- *Baton \$40 – students will be measured at 1st class and may borrow a baton until it arrives
- *Costume - Varies if participating in recital, parades, or competitions.

PAYMENTS:

Payments can be made by cash, Venmo, PayPal, or Zelle.

Payments are expected at the first class of each session.

A \$10 late fee will be added if payment is not received by the 15th of the month if paying in monthly installments.

All accounts must be cleared by May 31st of each year to remain in good standing.

There is a \$30 NSF additional fee for any declined payments.

*It should go without saying, but this is my source of income.

I absolutely do this because I love children and our sport, but I am solely responsible for the expenses involved in running this business. therefore your debts will be sent to collection if not paid by May 31.

INSTRUCTOR:

Lori Perkins – is the current President of the USTA Texas Twirling Council. As a United States Twirling Association Certified Master Judge, Coach, and Clinician for more than 30 years, she is well known for mentoring new coaches and judges, serving as a contest director, and coaching numerous State, Regional, National, International Champions, and World Team members in multiple twirling organizations. She is considered one of the nation's top choreographers having won the National Choreographer of the Year award four times so far in her career, and continues to choreograph for baton programs in TX, LA, OK, MS, WI, and KY. Many of her twirlers have earned Collegiate Feature Twirler positions throughout the nation, including her daughter, who was the 2017-2023 Feature Twirler at the University of Oklahoma earning a masters degree in City Planning while on full scholarship!. Lori has been recognized for her service in many leadership positions including 10 years on the USTA National Board of Directors, Director of the USTA Essentials Commission, and Director of the Growth and Development Department. During her competitive career, she twirled as the McNeese State University Feature Twirler while earning her degree in Education. She was a 15 time LA. State Grand Champion, along with multiple Central Region Grand Champion titles, 9 National Championships, 1 International Gold Medal, and was a member of the 1993 Class A WGI World Champion Winter Guard – Nouveaux. In 2022, she retired from her career as the Special Education Department Chair and Algebra I Co-teacher in Magnolia ISD to focus on her family and devote her time to developing new generations of baton twirlers. She has been happily married for 32 years to her husband Steve, and has two adult children, Emily and Alex.

Etiquette:

1. Please ask if you need help with anything.
2. Be prompt! On time is late. Show up ready to twirl!
3. If you borrow something, return it promptly.
4. Please do not share videos of our routines on social media without asking permission.
5. Mind your manners. You never know who is listening.
6. Do not talk to judges. If you have a question or complaint, take it up with your primary coach.
7. Vulgarity and profanity have NO place in our sport.
8. Cover yourself appropriately. Wear the proper undergarments to ensure that you are covered.
9. Smoking, vaping, underage drinking, drugs, etc. are absolutely not allowed by athletes, and parents should refrain from partaking when in the presence of athletes.
10. Communication is key. If you are unsure, ask. If you are unhappy, call and talk it out. Most situations can be resolved when both parties can express their views honestly.
11. Communicate professionally and always with kindness.
12. Please bring a friend to try a class and spread the word of our classes as often as possible!
13. Sharing drinks, lip stick, etc. is dangerous. Please ensure that you have all of your own supplies.
14. Check your email often for important information. We hold the athletes themselves accountable for all communication and ensuring they show up with needed equipment.
15. Attendance is critical to your proper progression.
16. Focus on your child/athlete. Every athlete is treated with respect as an individual and punishments are private.
17. Err on the side of caution. We teach our children through our actions, much more than our words. Be the example.
18. Remember that your coaches have your best interest at heart even when you don't understand the logic behind the decisions.
